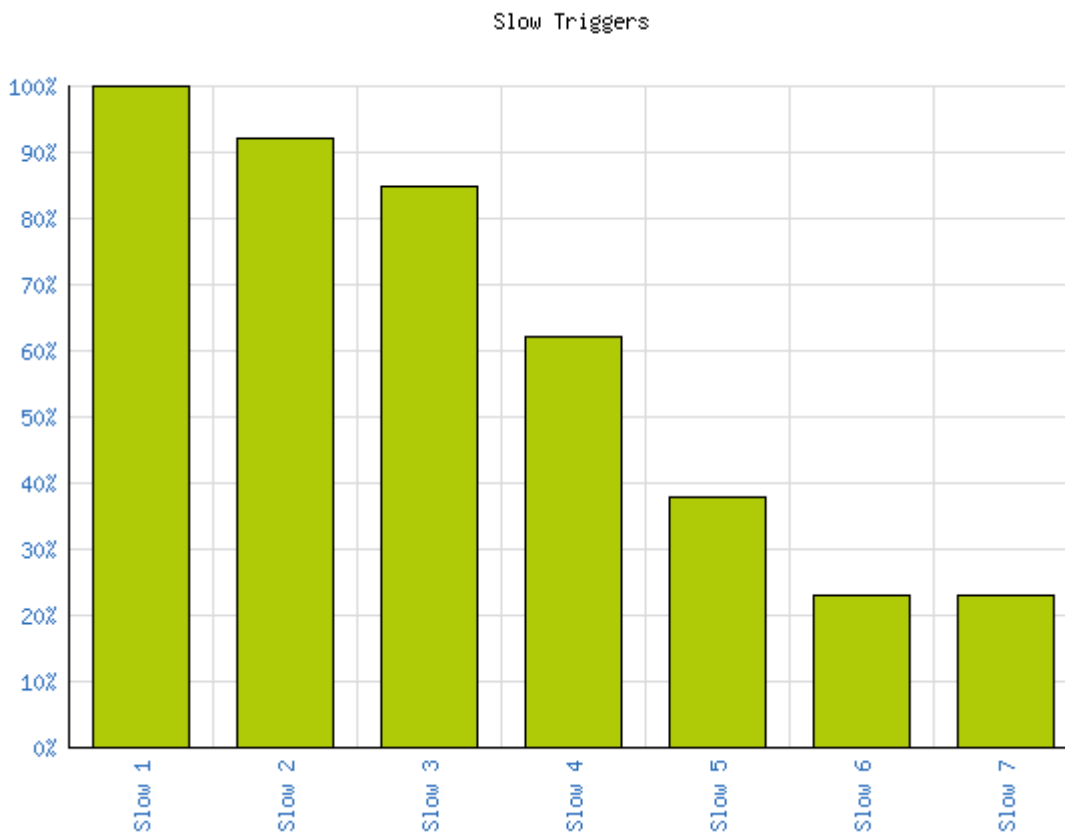

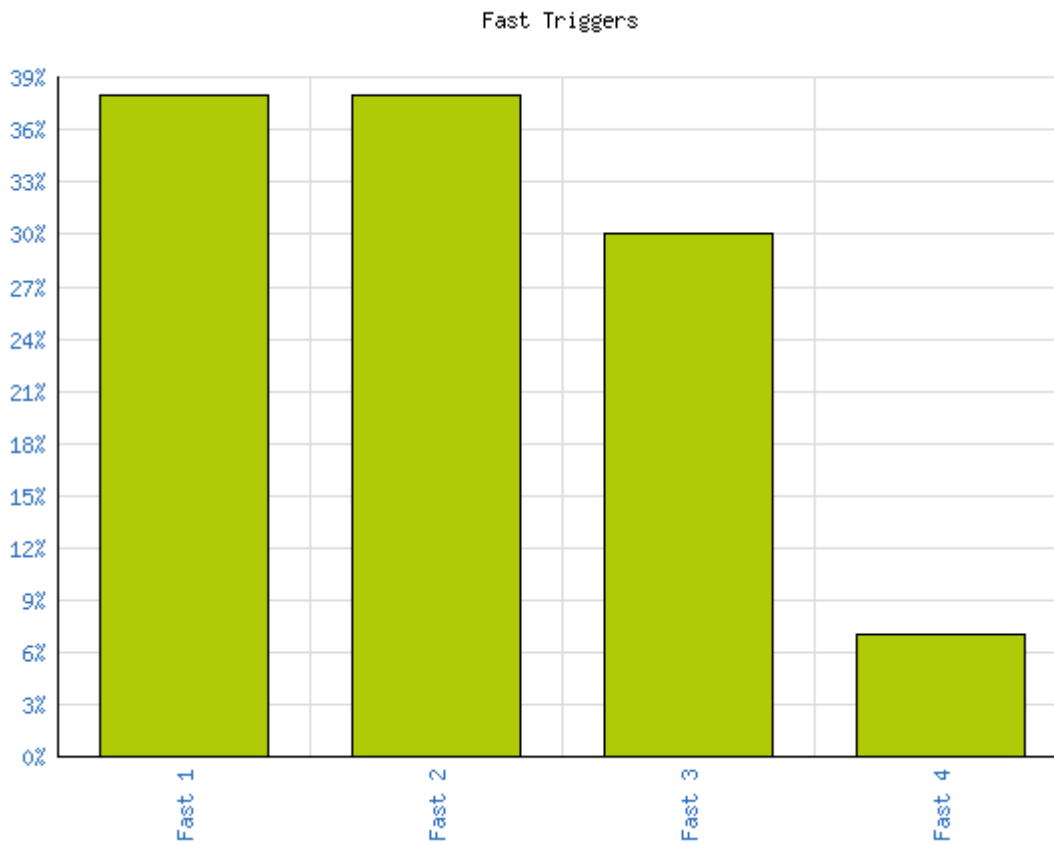

Slow Triggers



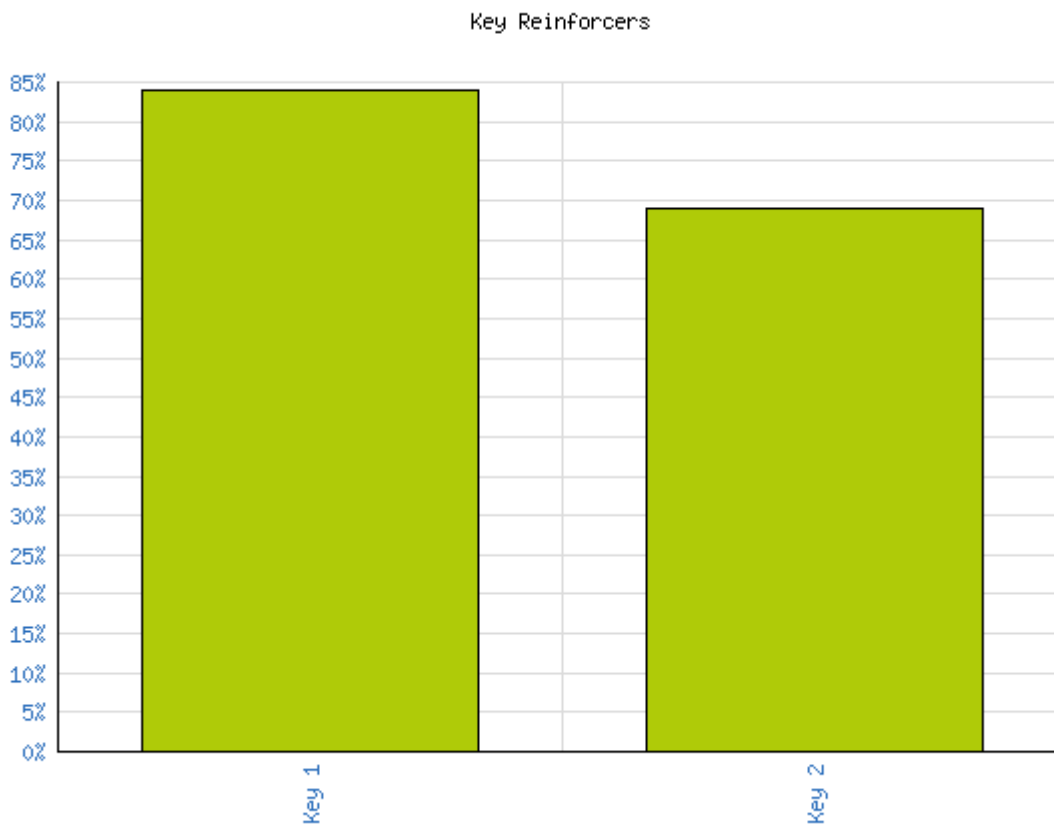
1. Loud places (100% - 13 out of 13 incidents)
2. Crowded places (92% - 12 out of 13 incidents)
3. Winter (85% - 11 out of 13 incidents)
4. Target 21 staff and relief staff at the house. (62% - 8 out of 13 incidents)
5. Early Morning, Early Evening (38% - 5 out of 13 incidents)
6. Unfamiliar places (23% - 3 out of 13 incidents)
7. Physically unwell (23% - 3 out of 13 incidents)

Fast Triggers



1. Is rushed or hurried (38% - 5 out of 13 incidents)
2. Asked to do too many tasks in one go (38% - 5 out of 13 incidents)
3. Asked to do a complex task (31% - 4 out of 13 incidents)
4. Asked to wait for something (8% - 1 out of 13 incidents)

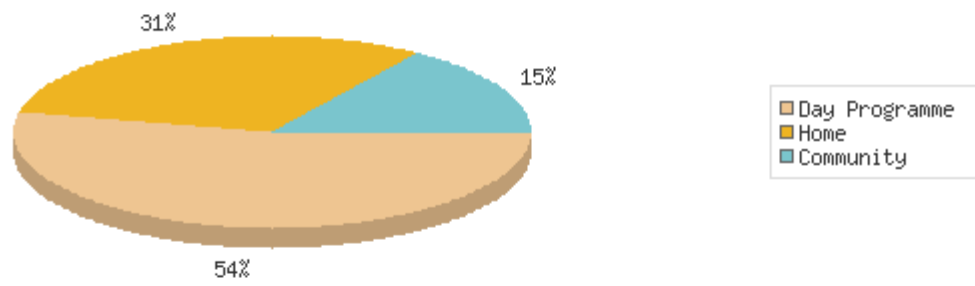
Key Reinforcers



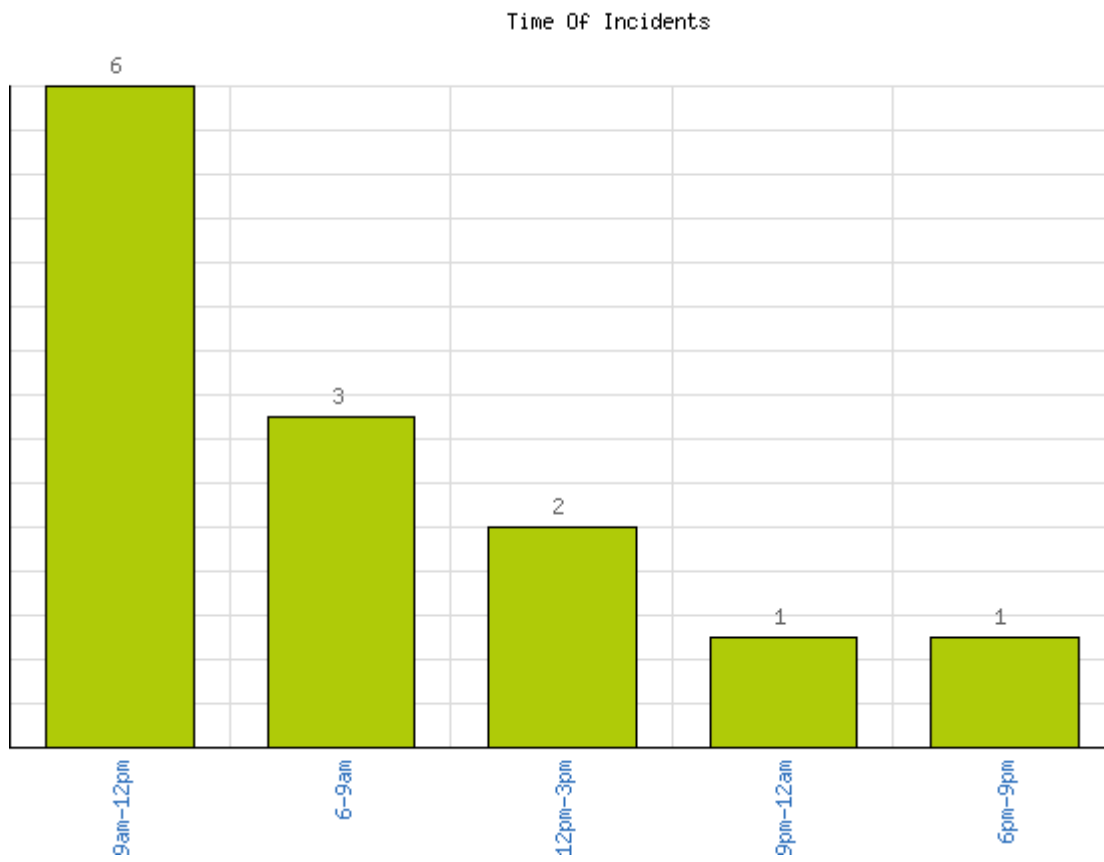
1. Avoiding people (85% - 11 out of 13 incidents)

Location Of Incidents

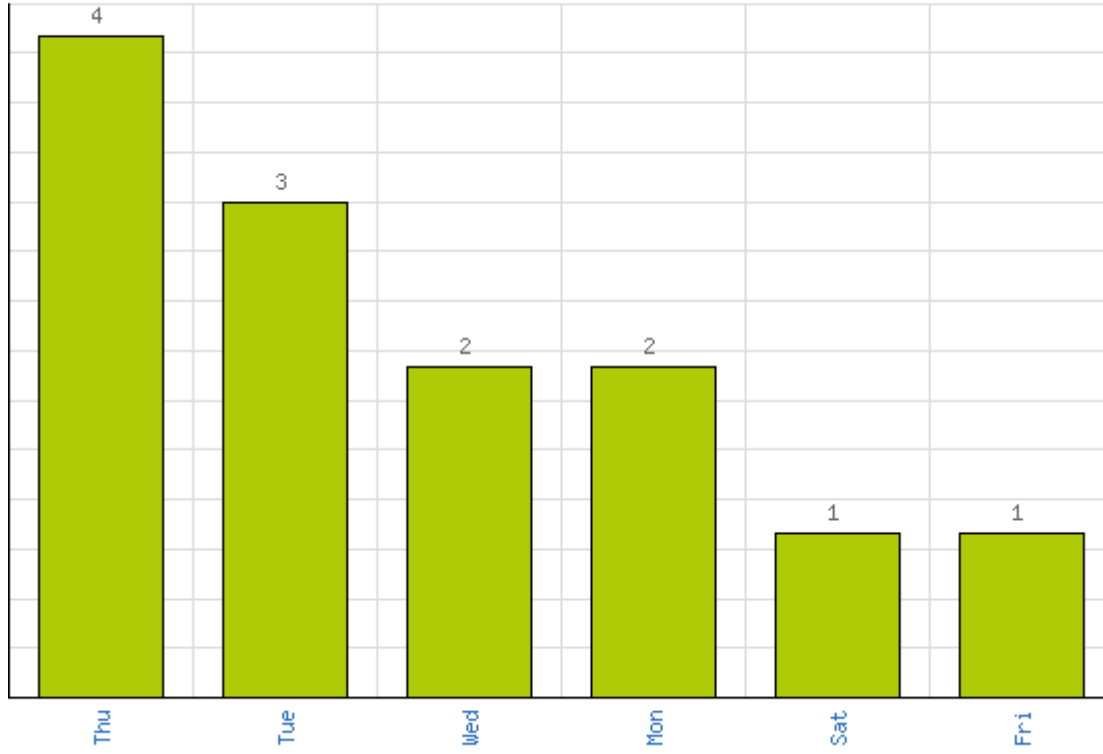


Time of Incidents



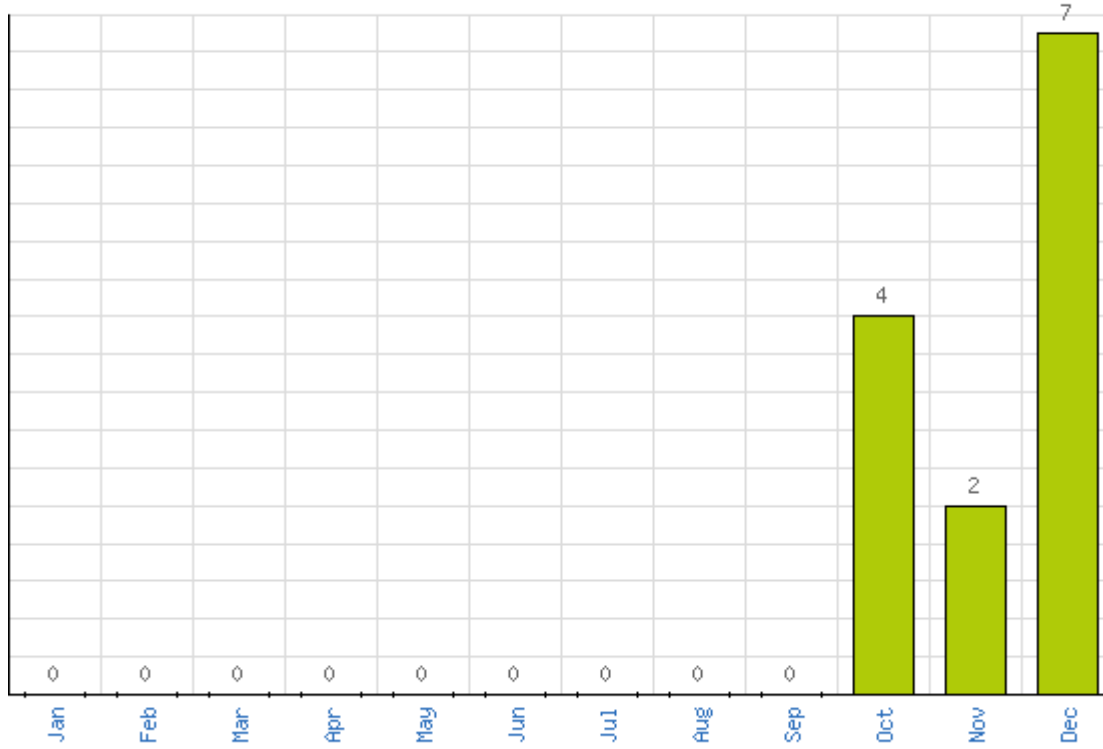
Days of Incidents

Incidents By Month



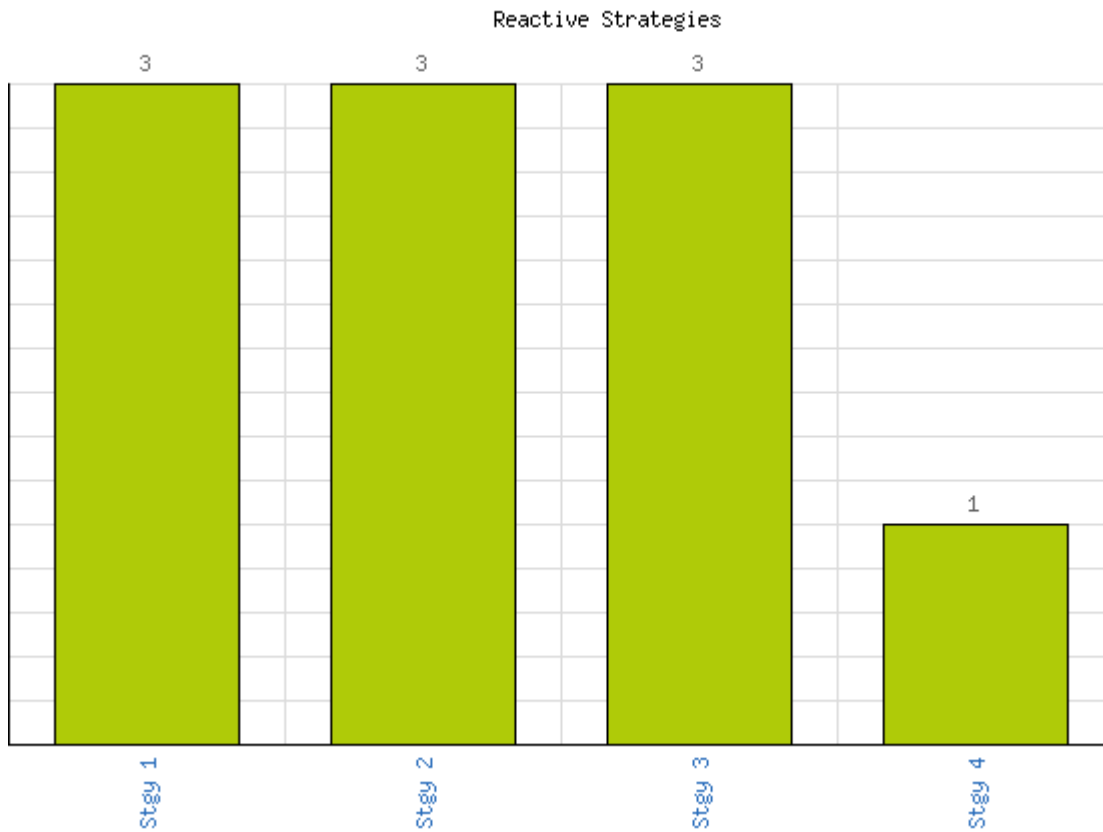
Average Severity: 3.5

1=Easy to manage; 10=Extremely difficult to manage

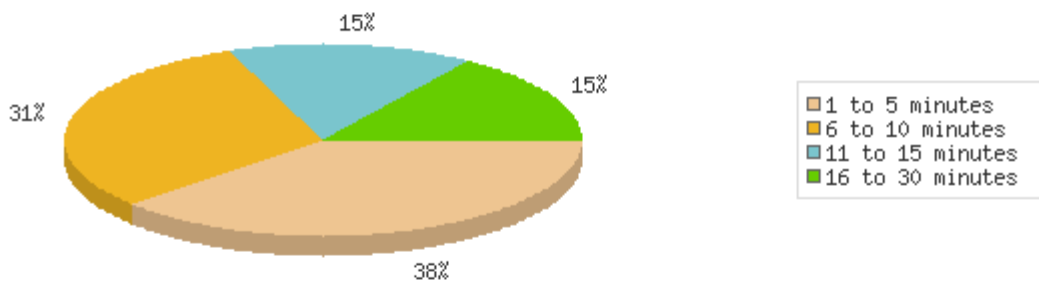
Reactive Strategies Used

- 4. As required (8% - 1 out of 13 incidents)

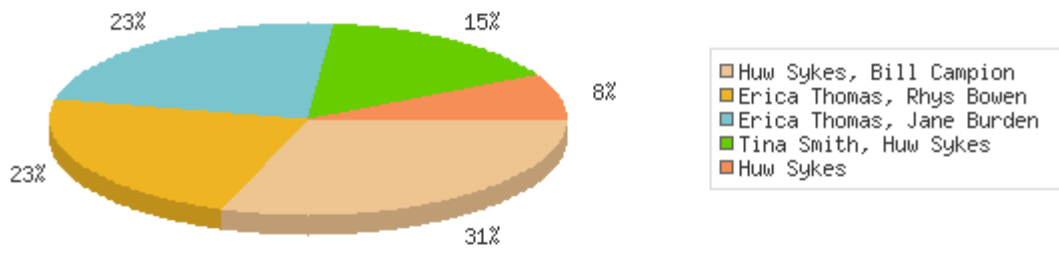
Incident Duration

Incident Durations



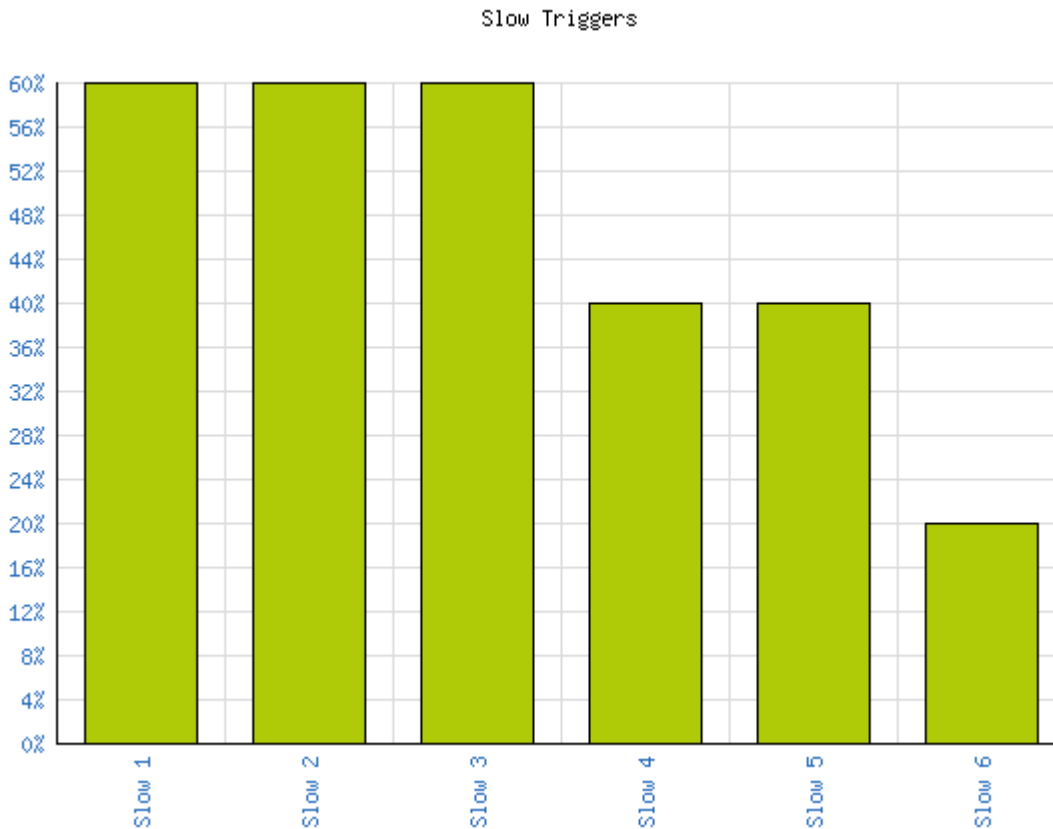

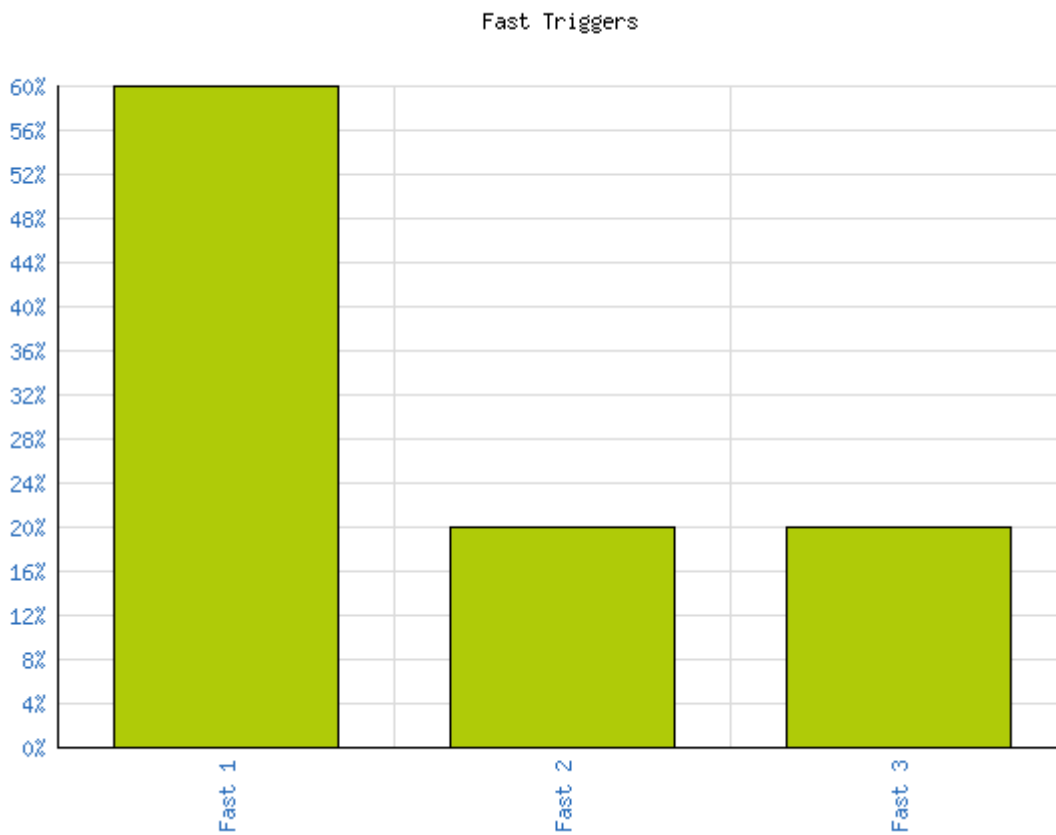

Slow Triggers



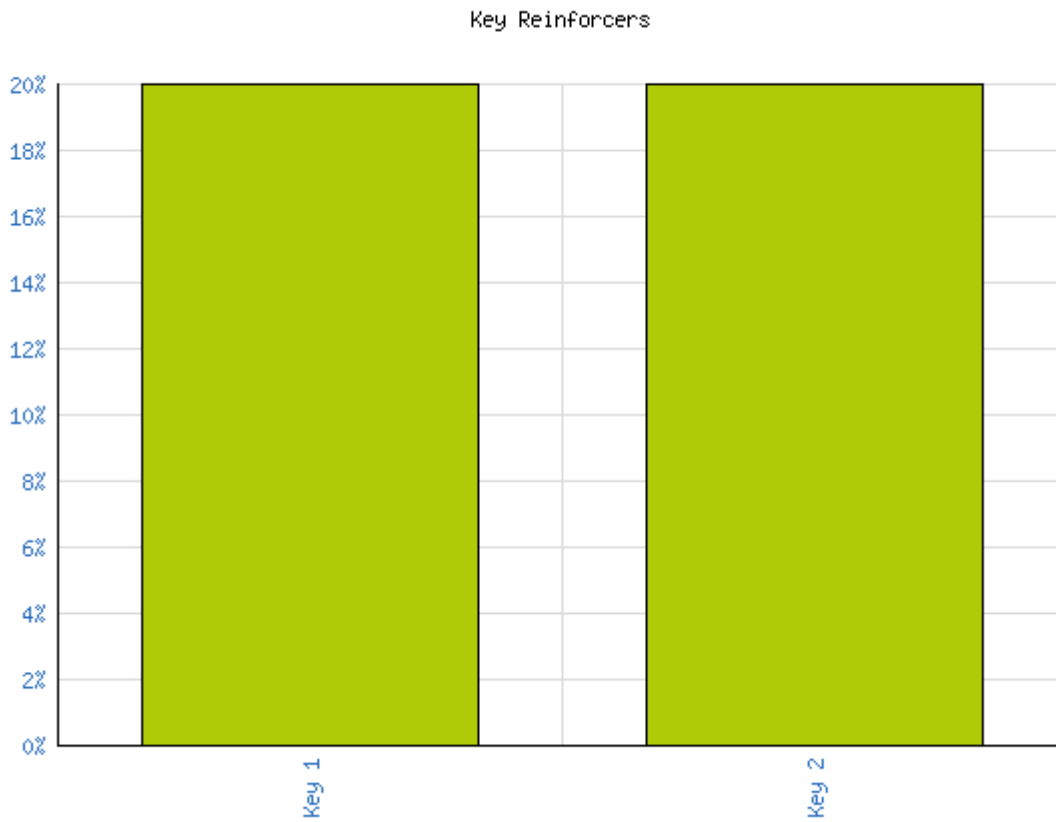
1. Times when there's not a lot going on OR times when there is too much happening and Tom can't handle it. (60% - 3 out of 5 incidents)
2. Crowded places (60% - 3 out of 5 incidents)
3. Late Morning, Early Afternoon, Late Afternoon (60% - 3 out of 5 incidents)
4. Loud places (40% - 2 out of 5 incidents)
5. Staff who not confident in working with Tom. (40% - 2 out of 5 incidents)
6. Quiet places (20% - 1 out of 5 incidents)

Fast Triggers



1. Is rushed or hurried (60% - 3 out of 5 incidents)
2. A favourite activity is cancelled (20% - 1 out of 5 incidents)
3. Asked to wait for something (20% - 1 out of 5 incidents)

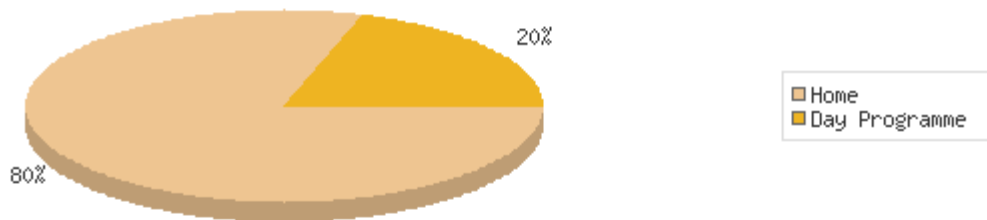
Key Reinforcers



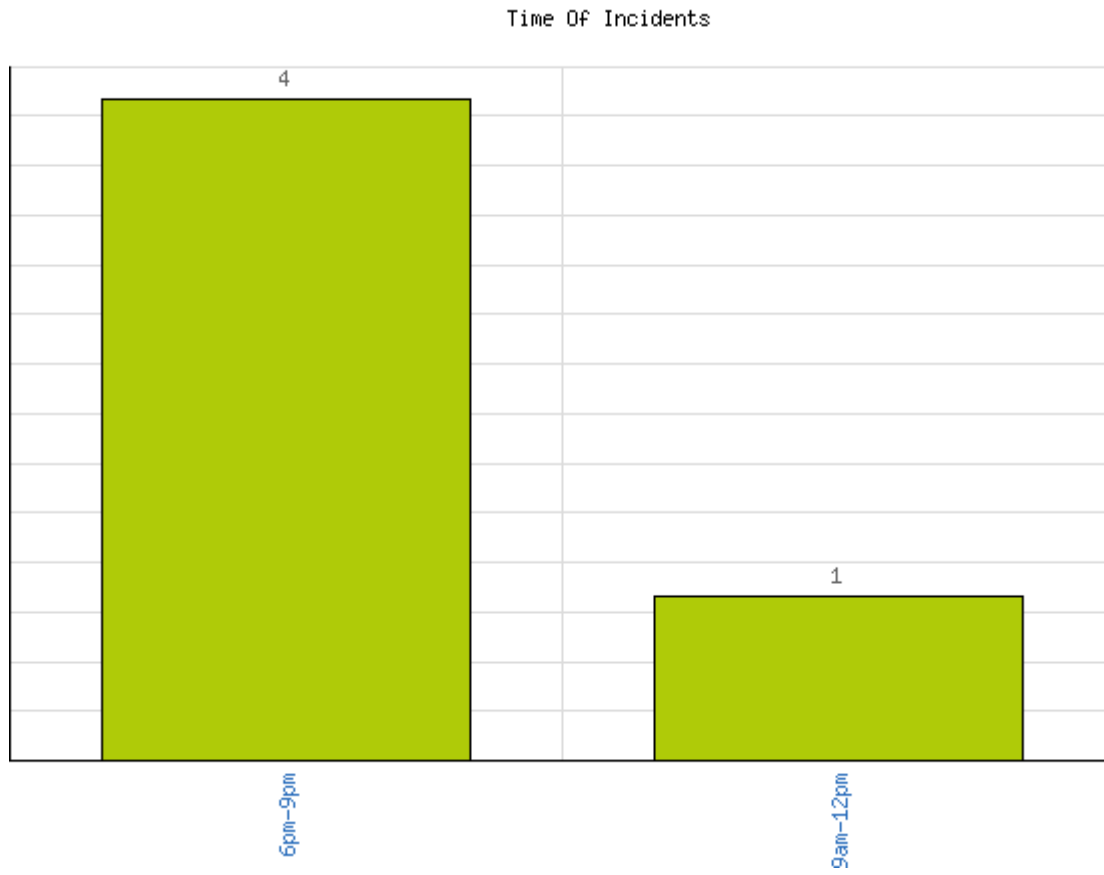
1. Avoiding activities (20% - 1 out of 5 incidents)

Location of Incidents

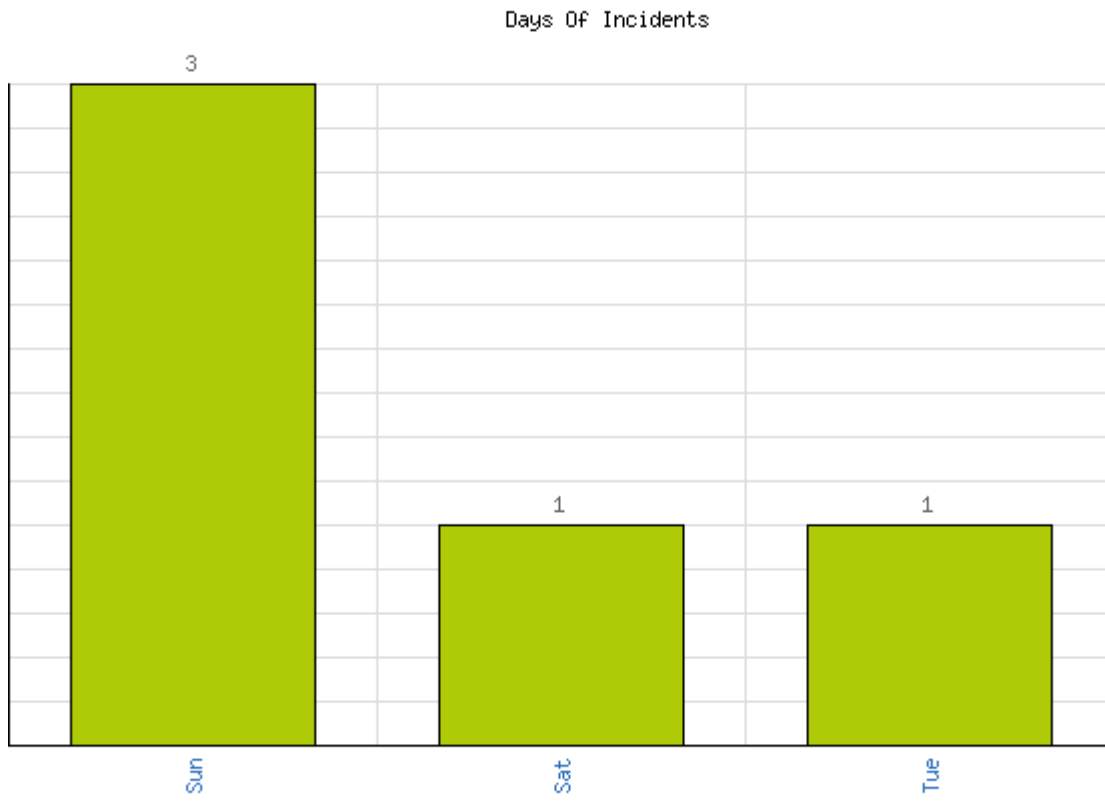
Location Of Incidents



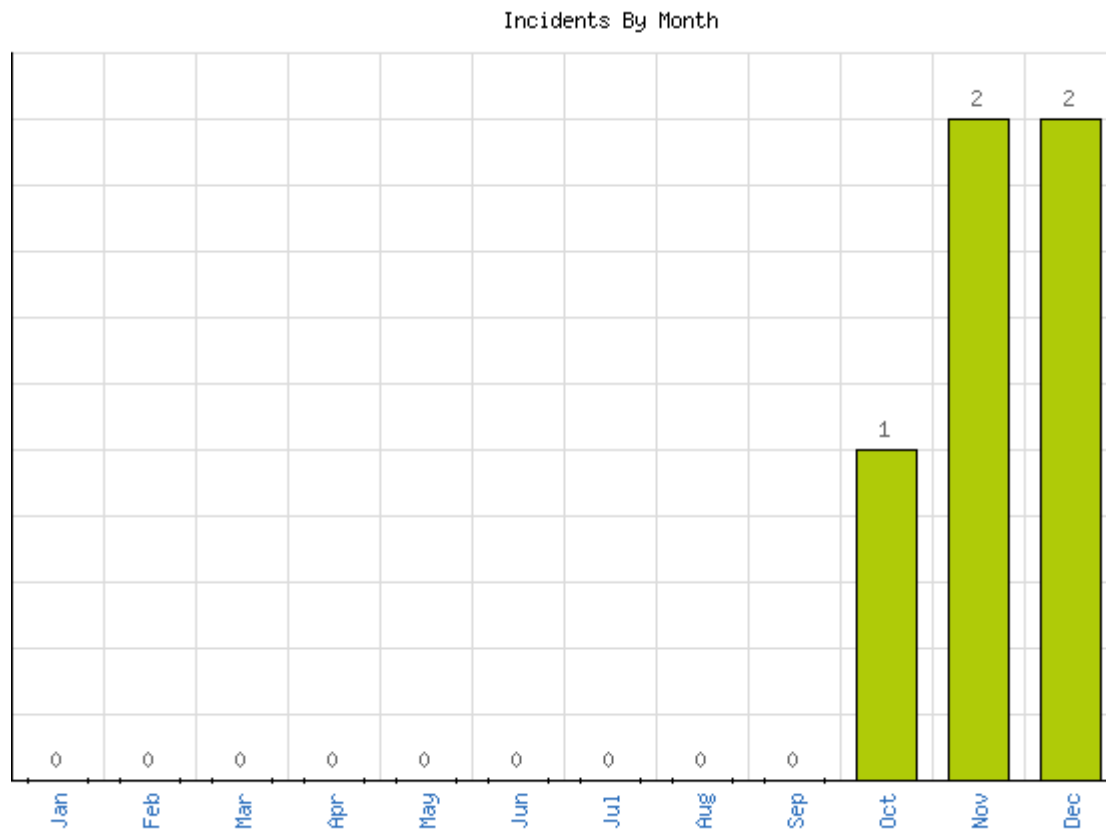
Time of Incidents

Average Ease of Management: 1.4

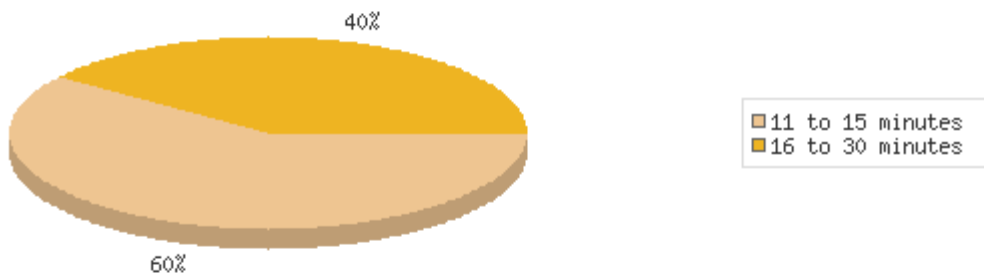
